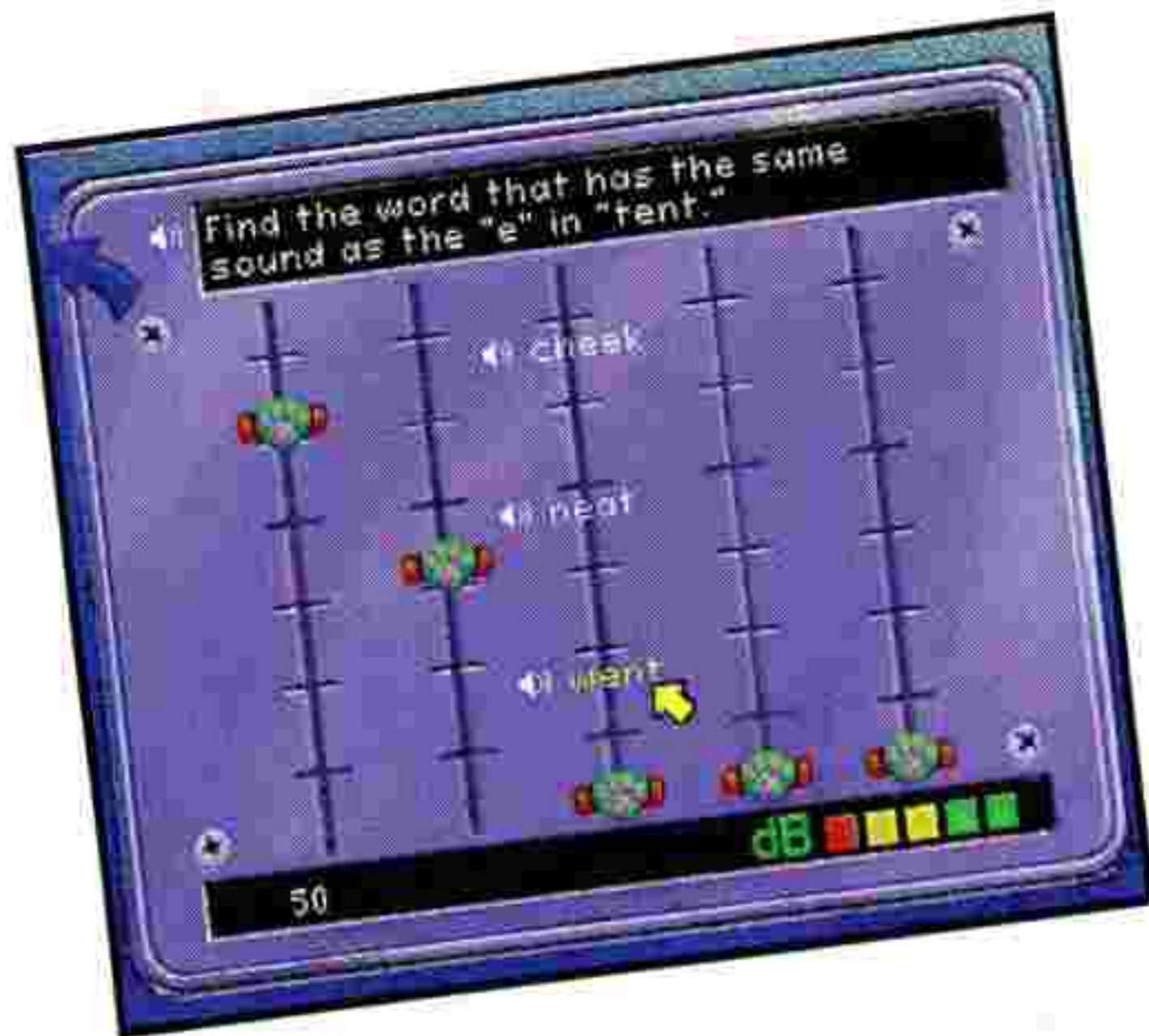
Set up your PlayStation® game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the power is off before inserting or removing a disc. Insert the disc and close the disc door. Insert the game controller(s) and turn on the PlayStation game console. Follow the on-screen instructions to start the adventure.



- Use the **arrows** on the game controller to move the pointer.
- Use the **X button** on the game controller for clicking.
- At the opening screen, click the **pictures of the characters** to learn more about them and their roles in the band.
- Click **New Game** to view the introductory story and begin the game.
- Click once to skip the introductory story.
- Click **Saved Game** if you are returning to a game.
- Click the **television** in the lower-left corner of the screen to play the introductory story.
- Click the **dog bone** in the lower-right corner of the screen to turn the music on or off.
- Click **Exit** in the upper-left corner of the screen to exit the game.

K9.5-2—We Are the Dogs!

The members of K9.5 are fighting a deadline to mix the tracks for their CD. By playing the games, your child can help them set the levels for their final soundtrack mix. To begin the game, click **level 1, 2, or 3** on either the "Guitar Track," the "Keyboard Track," or the "Drum Track." To mix the whole soundtrack, your child needs to complete all three levels of each game.



"Guitar Track"

In this game your child will identify vowel sounds to adjust faders on the control panel. Once your child has completed all three levels, he or she will be rewarded by hearing the full guitar soundtrack. Have your child:

- read the instruction at the top of the screen
- click the **speaker** in the upper-left corner of the screen to hear the instruction read aloud
- click the **speaker** next to each word to hear the word read aloud
- click the word that correctly answers the instruction
- click the **flashing arrow** at the bottom of the screen to go to the next set of questions

To exit the game and begin a new one, click the **arrow** in the upper-left corner of the screen.

"Keyboard Track"

In this game your child will develop vocabulary skills as he or she uses hints to form the correct word. Once your child has completed all three levels, he or she will be rewarded by hearing the full keyboard soundtrack. Have your child:

- read the description at the top of the screen
- click the **speaker** in the upper-left corner of the screen to hear the description read aloud
- click **Stop/Spin** to choose the correct answer
- click **OK** at the bottom of the screen when the answer is complete



To exit the game and begin a new one, click the **arrow** in the upper-left corner of the screen.



"Drum Track"

In this game your child tests his or her knowledge in literature, geography, mathematics, and science as he or she puts syllables together to form words. Once your child has completed all three levels, he or she will be rewarded by hearing the full drum soundtrack. Have your child:

- read the description at the top of the screen
- click the **speaker** in the upper-left corner of the screen to hear the description read aloud
- click **Stop/Spin** to choose the correct answer
- click **OK** at the bottom of the screen when the answer is complete

To exit the game and begin a new one, click the **arrow** in the upper-left corner of the screen.

To help your child with syllables, have him or her look around the room and name objects that have three or more syllables in their names (for example, "recliner" or "television").

Extending the Learning Experience

Family Activities

Play It Again, Sam

Watch a movie with your child, paying attention to the music. Is some music played repeatedly? What kind of music is used for scary or sad scenes? Talk about what someone creating a soundtrack might have to think about while writing the music.

Syllable Hunt

With your child, look through the newspaper and have a contest to see who can find the word with the most syllables. If your child does not know the meaning of a word, help him or her look the word up in the dictionary.

Hear, Here

Homophones are words that sound the same but have different spellings and meanings, such as "hair" and "hare," "made" and "maid," and "feet" and "feat." Ask your child if he or she knows any homophones. Write a list of homophones. See if your child can use them in a sentence.
